Commercial Tax Abatement Available in the City of Creston

The City of Creston offers a Commercial Tax Abatement on certain types of qualifying improvements. These include new construction on vacant land, additions to existing structures, replacement of existing structures and rehabilitation of existing structures.

There are certain qualifications for eligibility. An overview of the criteria is that improvements must be added during the time the area is designated as a revitalization area – through December 31, 2013; Improvements consisting of rehabilitation or additions to existing buildings must increase the actual value of the property by at least 15%; Improvements must be completed in accordance with all applicable zoning and other regulations of the City and finally the improvements must not be located within an area subject to tax incremental financing (see actual ordinance for specifics).

All applications must be approved by the Creston City Council.

Update on New Shooting Complex Opening in Union County

By mid-summer this year Union County will have a new shooting complex. High Lakes Outdoor Alliance, Union County Conservation, and the Iowa Department of Natural Resources have partnered to develop this complex at the north end of 3 Mile Lake. The complex will sit on 80 acres and be located at 2216 130th St. and will house 5 trap fields, 1 skeet field, and a rifle/pistol range. The plan is to have scheduled leagues, registered shoots, and times that the complex is open to the public. This complex will allow area schools to expand or start competitive shooting opportunities through FFA or 4H. Shooting workshops for kids and adults will be held. A membership fee of \$45/year will be available but not necessary to use the facility during times it is open to the public. Safety and environmental issues have been addressed during the planning process. Strict safety rules will be in place and all members will be required to attend a 4 hour safety training session before they can use the facility. During the open times a range manager will be on site and will make sure all safety rules are followed. As for the environmental issues, the area has been designed for reclamation of the lead shot and buffer areas will be established to keep the shot away from 3 Mile Lake. The complex was designed by Garden and Associates using guidelines from Department of Natural Resources and the National Rifle Association.

This first phase of this complex is expected to cost approximately \$145,000.00 and funding has come from Dekko: \$50,000.00, Endow Union County \$22,000.00, Creston Betterment Foundation \$20,000.00, DNR trap grant: \$22,350.00, Union County (road work): \$18,978.00, Union County Conservation: \$5,000.00, and the remaining balance from High Lakes Outdoor Alliance. The second phase will be the construction of a building that will include restrooms, kitchen area, meeting room, and storage area for this complex.
